PRELIMINARY ORDER FOR EXPEDITED DISCOVERY

Upon motion of the Defendant Tech Traders, Inc. ("TTI") and it appearing to the Court that there is a need to permit expedited discovery in this case to insure TTI can properly prepare to defend itself at the hearing on Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction against TTI,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that TTI is granted leave to take the depositions of the individual Defendants, representatives of the corporate Defendants, and representatives of the Plaintiff who have conducted investigatory and/or other work on this case relative to the preliminary injunction.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that TTI is granted leave to issue subpoenas for documents and testimony to non-parties and to request that the parties and non-parties produce, on an expedited basis, any documents relating to the subject matter herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that depositions of the parties shall be taken upon three (3) business days notice, and document production requests shall be responded to within two (2) business days. Nonparties shall be given (7) days notice for depositions and document requests.
