Cause	Penalty / Fine
A. <u>1. Materially incomplete or erroneous shipping instructions or material adjustment to instructions.</u>	<u>\$200 per business day (assessed against the buyer and payable to seller).</u>
<u>2. Failure by the seller to properly follow shipping instructions within seven business days after receipt of instructions.</u>	\$200 per business day (assessed against the seller and payable to buyer).

(Remainder of penalty schedule unchanged)
