
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By order issued July 27, 2007 the parties to the above identified cases were ordered to show cause why the complaints should not be dismissed on grounds that all issues have been resolved, or, in the alternative, that Complainants have abandoned prosecution. Complainants did not respond to that order. However, counsel for Respondents reported that the parties had reached settlement. Complainants have failed to respond to orders issued by this Court on April 3, 2007, May 7, 2007, and the Order to Show Cause issued July 27, 2007.

This court deems that all issues have been settled. Accordingly, the above

identified claims are DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.
