

ORDER PURSUANT TO  
DELEGATED AUTHORITY

Richard Mesirow ("Mesirow") filed an appeal from the Chicago Mercantile Exchange's ("CME") decision in this case, and moved for a stay of decision's May 21, 2007 effective date.
