ORDER DISMISSING REPARATION PROCEEDING

Having settled this matter in January 2000, the parties filed a written stipulation of dismissal in accordance with 17 C.F.R. §12.21(a). See Stipulation Of Dismissal, filed January 21, 2000. They requested that prior to dismissing the case, the Court stay the proceeding until June 2000, to permit the parties to fully perform their settlement agreement. See Joint Motion to Stay Proceeding, filed January 14, 2000 ("Joint Motion"). The Court granted the Joint Motion. See Order Staying Proceeding Pending Full Performance of Settlement Agreement, filed January 14, 2000.

The Court's January 14, 2000 Order stated that if no party requested further proceedings by June 15, 2000, the Court would enter an order of dismissal. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the complaint is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety. See 17 C.F.R. §12.21(c).
