Dear Mr. Kirkpatrick:

Chicago Mercantile Exchange Inc. ("CME" or "Exchange") hereby notifies the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") of plans to terminate the Bitcoin Futures Market Maker Program ("Program"). The termination of the Program will be effective on March 1, 2018.

Exhibit 1 sets forth the terms of the Program. Modifications appear below, with additions <u>underlined</u> and deletions <del>overstruck</del>.

CME reviewed the designated contract market core principles ("Core Principles") as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act ("CEA"). During the review, CME staff identified the following Core Principles as potentially being impacted: Monitoring of Trading, Execution of Transactions, Protection of Market Participants, Compliance with Rules, and Recordkeeping

The Program does not impact the Exchange's ability to perform its trade practice and market surveillance obligations under the CEA. Exchange staff will monitor trading in the Program's product in order to prevent manipulative trading and market abuse. Additionally, the Exchange has implemented systems to track Program participants' volume to ensure proper distribution of earned incentives. The Program does not impact the Exchange's order execution. Participants in the Program will be selected by CME staff using criteria as set forth in Exhibit 1. Chapter 4 of the Exchange rules includes prohibitions against fraudulent, non-competitive, unfair or abusive practices. All participants must execute a contractual agreement with CME in which each participant will expressly agree to comply with, and be subject to, applicable regulations and Exchange rules. Additionally, the Program is subject to the Exchange's record retention policies, which comply with the CEA.

CME certifies that the Program complies with the CEA and the regulations thereunder. There were no substantive opposing views to this Program.

# **Bitcoin Futures Market Maker Program**

### Program Purpose

The purpose of this Program is to incentivize participants to support the development of the product listed below. A more liquid contract benefits all participants in the marketplace.

## Product Scope

Bitcoin futures ("BTC") that are traded on Globex® (the "Product").

### **Eligible Participants**

There is no limit to the number of participants in the Program. Participants may be CME members or nonmembers.

### Program Term

Start date is December 18, 2017. End date is March 31, 2018 March 1, 2018.

#### Hours

Designated time periods during RTH and ETH.

#### **Obligations**

Participants must quote continuous two-sided markets in the Product at maximum bid/ask spreads and minimum quote sizes.

#### Incentives

Upon satisfying all Program obligations, as determined by the Exchange, participants may be eligible to receive predetermined incentives.

### Monitoring and Termination of Status

The Exchange shall monitor trading activity and participants' performance and shall retain the right to revoke Program participant status if it concludes from review that a Program participant has failed to meet the obligations of the Program.
