CONCISE EXPLANATION AND ANALYSIS OF THE OPERATION, PURPOSE, AND EFFECT OF THE PROPOSED RULE AND ITS COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT, INCLUDING CORE PRINCIPLES AND THE COMMISSION'S REGULATIONS THEREUNDER

Eurex Clearing is proposing to amend its Clearing Conditions and Price List to reflect a new contract naming convention for 3M SARON® Futures (FSR3). For the avoidance of doubt, Eurex Clearing clears these contracts outside the scope of its DCO license, which applies only to swaps.

Additionally, concerning the already existing service of providing relevant reports to settlement institutions, a clarifying phrase is added to the Clearing Conditions.

Further information regarding the operation, purpose, and effect of the proposed amendments is discussed in the attached Eurex Clearing Circular 075/21, which is appended as Attachment A.

Eurex Clearing has identified the following derivatives clearing organization ("DCO") Core Principle as potentially being relevant to the above amendments:

1. DCO Core Principle C (Participant and Product Eligibility): The proposed amendments will comply with DCO Core Principle C because the amendments introduce a new contract naming convention for a product Eurex Clearing clears outside the scope of its DCO license. All products cleared by Eurex Clearing under its DCO license will continue to be subject to appropriate standards in compliance with this Core Principle.
