Previously, pursuant to Submission No. 14-345 dated August 15, 2014, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") notified the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") of plans to implement the NYMEX European and Asian Petroleum Products High Performer Program ("Program").
