Dear Mr. Kirkpatrick:

Chicago Mercantile Exchange Inc. ("CME" or "Exchange") hereby notifies the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") of plans to extend the TOPIX Futures Fee Waiver Program ("Program") through February 28, 2021. All other terms remain unchanged. The extension of the Program will become effective on March 1, 2020.

Exhibit 1 sets forth the terms of the Program. Modifications appear below, with additions <u>underlined</u> and deletions <del>overstruck</del>.

CME reviewed the designated contract market core principles ("Core Principles") as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act ("CEA"). During the review, CME staff identified the following Core Principles as potentially being impacted: Monitoring of Trading, Execution of Transactions, Protection of Market Participants, Compliance with Rules, and Recordkeeping.

The Program is a general fee waiver that applies to all market participants. A general fee waiver does not incentivize manipulative trading or market abuse. The Program does not impact the Exchange's ability to perform its trade practice and market surveillance obligations under the CEA. The Exchange's market regulation staff will monitor trading in the products that are included in the Program to prevent manipulative trading and market abuse. The general fee waiver in the Program does not impact the Exchange's order execution. All market participants that execute trades in the products on Globex shall be entitled to participate. Chapter 4 of the Exchange rules includes prohibitions against fraudulent, non-competitive, unfair or abusive practices. The Program is subject to these rules.

CME certifies that the Program complies with the CEA and the regulations thereunder. There were no substantive opposing views to this Program.

# **TOPIX Futures Fee Waiver Program**

### **Program Purpose**

The purpose of this Program is to encourage adoption and incentivize market participants to trade TOPIX futures on the CME Globex Platform ("Globex"). The resulting increase in liquidity on the central limit order book benefits all participant segments in the market.

### **Product Scope**

Yen Denominated TOPIX Futures ("TPY") that are traded on Globex ("Product").

## **Eligible Participants**

There is no limit to the number of participants that may participate in the Program. Participants may be CME members or non-members. The fee incentives described below will be automatically applied to all trades executed in the Product by all market participants.

## **Program Term**

Start date is September 1, 2018. End date is February 29, 2020 February 28, 2021.

## **Hours**

## **Incentives**

<u>Fee Waivers</u>: All market participants will receive fee waivers for all transactions in the Product executed on Globex.
