Chicago Mercantile Exchange Inc. ("CME") and The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc. ("CBOT") (collectively, the "Exchanges") certify to the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or the "Commission") the expansion of the block trade reporting window for the S&P GSCI Commodity Index Futures, S&P GSCI ER Index Futures, Bloomberg Commodity Futures and Options and Bloomberg Roll Select Commodity Index Futures Contracts (the "Contracts") and associated Basis Trade at Index Close ("BTIC") functionality as noted in Table 1. below from five (5) to fifteen (15) minutes effective Sunday, October 13, 2024, for first trade date Monday, October 14, 2024.

^{*}The Options on Bloomberg Commodity Index Futures contract will be initially listed for trading and clearing effective on trade date September 23, 2024 and will be subject to a block trade reporting window of 5 minutes (see CFTC Filing 24-282 dated September 6, 2024). Effective trade date October 14, 2024, the block trade reporting window for the Options on the Bloomberg Commodity Index Futures contract will be expanded to 15 minutes as noted in the Table 1. above.

The 15-minute block trade reporting window shall apply to all trading hours.

Upon review the Exchanges note an increased institutional need for sophisticated strategies which may often require the execution of multi-leg block transactions. The Rule Amendments are intended to provide market participants sufficient time to report block transactions to the Exchanges across all time zones and harmonize such reporting requirements with other Exchange products.

The Exchange reviewed the designated contract market ("DCM") core principles ("Core Principles") as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and identified that the Rule Amendments may have some bearing on the following Core Principles:

- <u>Compliance with Rules</u>: The Exchanges provide guidance to the marketplace on the regulatory requirements attendant to block trades. This guidance is intended to assist market participants in remaining in compliance with Rule 526. ("Block Trades") and is therefore in compliance with this Coe Principle.
- Availability of General Information: The Exchange will release a Special Executive Report ("SER") regarding the Rule Amendments. The SER will also be posted on the CME Group website.
- <u>Execution of Transactions:</u> The Rule Amendments comply with this Core Principle and CFTC Regulation 1.38 (Execution of transactions), which allow DCMs to authorize transactions that are executed away from the DCM's centralized marketplace based on terms specified by the DCM and submitted to the Commission.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Act and CFTC Regulation 40.6(a), the Exchange herby certifies that the Rule Amendments comply with the Act., including regulation under the Act. There were no opposing views to the proposal.
