  Principle by making public daily information on settlement prices, volume, open interest, and
  opening and closing ranges for the Contracts which will be published daily on the Exchanges'
  website.
- <u>Compliance with Rules</u>: The Exchanges shall continue its normal practice to establish, monitor, and enforce compliance with the rules of the Contracts, including the expansion of the listing schedule of the Contracts.
- <u>Execution of Transactions</u>: The Exchanges will continue its current practice of providing a competitive, open, and efficient market mechanism for executing transactions in the Contracts, including the expansion of the listing schedule of the Contracts.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Act and CFTC Regulation 40.6(a), the Exchanges hereby certify that the Rule Amendments comply with the Act, including regulations under the Act. There were no substantive opposing views to the proposal.
