Commodity Exchange, Inc. ("COMEX" or "Exchange") is certifying to the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or the "Commission") amendments to Rule 867102.E. ("Termination of Trading") of the HMS 80/20 Ferrous Scrap, CFR Turkey (Platts TSI) Futures contract (Commodity Code FSF; Rulebook Chapter 867) (the "Contract") effective on Monday, December 9, 2024 (collectively, the "Rule Amendments").

867102. TRADING SPECIFICATIONS

867102.E. Termination of Trading

Trading in the contract shall terminate at the settlement time on the last U.K. business day of the contract month. If such day is not an Exchange business day, trading in the contract shall terminate on the Exchange business day that is immediately prior which is also a U.K. business day. Trading shall terminate on the last business day of the contract month. Business days are based on the U.K. Public Holiday calendar.

[End of Rule.]

Currently, Rule 867102.E. references the U.K. holiday calendar and that trading in the Contract terminates at the close of trading on the last U.K. business day. Pursuant to the Rule Amendments, if such day is not an Exchange business day, trading in the Contract shall terminate on the Exchange business day that is immediately prior which is also a U.K. business day.

The Exchange reviewed the designated contract market core principles (“Core Principles”) as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act (“Act”) and identified that the Rule Amendments may have some bearing on the following Core Principle:

- **Availability of General Information**: The Exchange will release a Special Executive Report (“SER”) regarding the Rule Amendments. The SER will also be posted on the CME Group website.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Act and CFTC Regulation 40.6, the Exchange hereby certifies that the Rule Amendments comply with the Act, including regulations under the Act. There were no substantive opposing views to the proposal.
