**Re: Weekly Notification of Rule Amendments**

Pursuant to the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC”) Regulation 40.6(d), ForecastEx is submitting this weekly notification of rule amendments for rules that were made effective during the week ending on December 13, 2024.

1. On December 10, 2024, ForecastEx amended its methodology for adding additional strikes to an existing month for a number of Forecast Contracts.
2. On December 11, 2024, ForecastEx amended its methodology for adding initial thresholds to new months for a number of Forecast Contracts.
