SUBJECT: Delisting Certain Previously-Listed Contract Months of Three (3) Singapore Gasoil 10 ppm Futures Contracts

Earlier today, February 27, 2017, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) delisted contract months beyond December 2017 for three (3) Singapore Gasoil 10 ppm futures contracts (the “Contracts”), as set out in the table below. There was no open interest in the delisted contract months.

The Contracts are currently listed for trading on CME Globex, and for submission for clearing through CME ClearPort.

It should be noted that the last listed contract months for the Contracts will be December 2017. The Contracts will be permanently delisted on January 2, 2018.

The Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC”) will be notified of the permanent delisting of the Contracts during the week of January 8, 2018 via the weekly notification procedures set forth in Part 40 of the CFTC Regulations.
