Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following product terms and conditions amendments made effective during the week of July 28, 2014.

On Tuesday, July 29, 2014, the Exchange gave notice that effective at the close of trading on Friday, September 29, 2014, the Exchange will suspend the registration (warranting) of the ME Alcoa aluminum brand onto COMEX warrants for delivery against the aluminum futures contract. As such, any unwarranted aluminum of ME Alcoa brand will no longer be deemed eligible at that time. Any currently registered (warranted) ME Alcoa aluminum or any ME Alcoa aluminum placed on warrant through Friday, September 19, 2014 will continue to be deliverable against the COMEX Aluminum futures contract up to close of trading on Monday, December 31, 2014.
