("CBOT" or "Exchange") is certifying to the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") amendments to the listing schedule for the Black Sea Sunflower Oil Financially Settled (Platts) Futures contract ("the Contract") such that the Exchange shall cease listing additional contract months as noted in the table below effective on Wednesday, March 16, 2022.

- <u>Availability of General Information</u>: The Exchange will make publicly available the details of the Rule Amendments by publishing a Special Executive Report ("SER") to the marketplace. The SER will be available on CME Group's website.
- <u>Prevention of Market Disruption</u>: Following the period of suspension, trading in the Contract will continue to be subject to the rules of the Exchange, which include prohibitions on manipulation, price distortion, and disruption to the cash settlement process.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Act and CFTC Regulation 40.6(a), the Exchange hereby certifies that Rule Amendments comply with the Act, including all regulations under the Act.
