Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of March 30, 2020.

On Sunday, March 29, 2020 for trade date Monday, March 30, 2020, the Exchange amended the NYMEX Rule 300.20. ("Strike Price Listing and Exercise Procedures") table for the Chicago Ethanol (Platts) Average Price Option contract. The marketplace was informed of the amendments via SER 8543, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

On Friday, April 3, 2020, the Exchange implemented two (2) amendments to the NYMEX Rulebook Chapter 5 Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table (the "Table") to correct two (2) typographical errors. The first correction was implemented to the Single Month and All Month Accountability Levels for the Singapore Fuel Oil 380 cst (Platts) Average Price Option (commodity code: 8H). The Exchange erroneously noted that the Single Month and All Month Accountability Levels for 8H as 750 contracts and 1,000 contracts instead of 1,500 contracts for both. The second correction was implemented to the Single Month Accountability Level for the RBOB Gasoline Average Price Option (commodity code: RA). The Exchange erroneously noted that the Single Month Accountability Level for the RA as 7,000 contracts instead of 5,000 contracts. It should be noted that the Single Month and All Month Accountability Levels of 8H and RA should match their respective parent contracts, Singapore Fuel Oil 380 cst (Platts) Futures (Commodity Code: SE) and RBOB Gasoline Last Day Financial Futures (Commodity Code: 27) in which they have a 1:1 aggregation ratio. The corrected Table is attached under separate cover, in blackline format, as Exhibit B.

Effective Sunday, March 29, 2020 for trade date Monday, March 30, 2020, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") will amend NYMEX Rule 300.20. ("Strike Price Listing and Exercise Procedures") table (the "Table") for the Chicago Ethanol (Platts) Average Price Option contract (the "Contract").

Specifically, the Exchange will decrease the dynamically-listed strike price increment from \$0.05 to \$0.025 per gallon for all transactions of the Contract which are either executed on the CME Globex electronic trading platform or submitted for clearing via CME ClearPort as detailed in the table below. As a result of this amendment, the Exchange will further define that the minimum 5 strikes shall be at \$0.050 per gallon strike increment above and below the at-the-money strike.
