Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of April 29, 2019.

On May 1, 2019, Engelhart Warehousing (US) LLC, an existing Warehouse for the storage of COMEX Aluminum, requested that its facility (Warehouse 10) located in Owensboro, KY be withdrawn from its status as an approved COMEX Aluminum warehouse. This location is no longer available for the storage of COMEX Aluminum deliverable against the Exchange’s futures contract. The marketplace was alerted of the withdrawal via MKR# 05-01-19, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Also, on May 1, 2019, Engelhart Warehousing (US) LLC, an existing Warehouse for the storage of COMEX Copper and Zinc, requested that its facility (Warehouse 4) located in Owensboro, KY be withdrawn from its status as an approved COMEX Copper and Zinc warehouse. This location is no longer available for the storage of COMEX Copper and Zinc deliverable against the respective futures contracts. The marketplace was alerted of the withdrawal via MKR# 05-01-19B, which is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

Also, on May 1, 2019, Engelhart Warehousing (US) LLC, an existing Warehouse for the storage of COMEX Copper, requested that its facility (Warehouse 3) located in Owensboro, KY be withdrawn from its status as an approved COMEX Copper warehouse. This location is no longer available for the storage of COMEX Copper deliverable against the COMEX Copper futures contract. The marketplace was alerted of the withdrawal via MKR# 05-01-19C, which is attached hereto as Exhibit C.

Also, on May 1, 2019, Engelhart Warehousing (US) LLC, an existing Warehouse for the storage of COMEX Copper, requested that its facility (Warehouse 6) located in Owensboro, KY be withdrawn from its status as an approved COMEX Copper warehouse. This location is no longer available for the storage of COMEX Copper deliverable against the COMEX Copper futures contract. Also, on May 1, 2019, Engelhart Warehousing (US) LLC, an existing Warehouse for the storage of COMEX Copper, requested that its facility (Warehouse 7) located in Owensboro, KY be withdrawn from its status as an approved COMEX Copper warehouse. This location is no longer available for the storage of COMEX Copper deliverable against the COMEX Copper futures contract. The marketplace was alerted of the withdrawal via MKR# 05-01-19E, which is attached hereto as Exhibit E.

In accordance with the changes above, the Exchange updated the COMEX Rulebook Chapter 7 “Service Providers” Chart (“Chart”) for “Base Metals – Charges” and “Base Warehouses Weighmasters.” The Chart is attached under separate cover, in blackline format, as Exhibit F.
