Dear Mr. Kirkpatrick:

New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) is certifying to the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) the delisting of certain previously-listed contract months effective immediately on Friday, June 5, 2020 and an amendment to the listing schedule of the NY Harbor ULSD vs Low Sulphur Gasoil (1,000bbl) futures contract (“the Contract”) for trading on the CME Globex electronic trading platform and for submission for clearing via CME ClearPort effective Sunday, June 21, 2020 for trade date Monday June 22, 2020 (collectively, the “Rule Amendments”), as noted in the table below. There is no open interest in the delisted contract months – January 2024 and beyond.

The Exchange reviewed the designated contract market core principles (“Core Principles”) as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act (“CEA”) and identified that the Rule Amendments may have some bearing on the following Core Principles:

- **Compliance with Rules:** The Exchange shall continue its normal practice to establish, monitor and enforce compliance with the rule of the Contracts.
- **Availability of General Information:** The Exchange will publish a Special Executive Report (“SER”) to advise the marketplace of the Rule Amendments. The SER will also be posted on the CME Group website.
- **Execution of Transactions:** The Rule Amendments will not impede the Exchange’s ability as a designated contract market to provide a competitive, open, and efficient market mechanism for executing transactions of the Contract.
- **Emergency Authority:** There is no open interest in the delisted contract months of the Contract, and therefore there will be no market disruption related to their delisting.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Act and CFTC Regulation 40.6(a), the Exchange hereby certifies that the Rule Amendments comply with the Act, including regulations under the Act. There were no substantive opposing views to this proposal.
