Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of June 11, 2018.

On June 11, 2018, the Exchange amended the titles of two (2) petroleum futures contracts. The changes were non-substantive and administrative in nature. The marketplace was alerted of these changes via SER# 8153, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

On June 12, 2018, the Exchange was advised that S&P Global Platts will amend its methodology for assessing its FOB Singapore Gasoline 92 RON unleaded, 95 RON unleaded and 97 RON unleaded benchmarks starting July 1, 2019. The marketplace was alerted of these upcoming changes via SER# 8174, which is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

SUBJECT: Amendments to the Contract Titles of Two (2) Petroleum Futures Contracts

Effective Monday June 11, 2018, New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) will amend the contract titles of two (2) petroleum futures contracts (the “Contracts”) as described in the table below.

The Contracts are available for trading on the CME Globex electronic platform and for submission for clearing via CME ClearPort.

The Exchange will also amend all references to the Contracts throughout the NYMEX Rulebook to reflect the new titles. The rulebook chapters and commodity codes will remain unchanged. The Exchange will also implement the amendment to the position limit table within Chapter 5 of the NYMEX rulebook to reflect the revised naming convention. This change will not affect existing position limits of the Contracts.

Please note that the title changes and related amendments are administrative in nature and will, in no manner, impact the economic structure of the Contracts.

The Commodity Futures Trading Commission (CFTC) will be notified of the product name changes during the week of June 18, 2018, via the weekly notification procedures set forth in Part 40 of the CFTC Regulations.

SUBJECT: **Platts Announcement to Amend Singapore 92 RON, 95 RON, 97 RON Gasoline Specifications Effective July 2019**

New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) has been advised that S&P Global Platts (“Platts”) will amend its methodology for assessing its FOB Singapore Gasoline 92 RON unleaded, 95 RON unleaded and 97 RON unleaded benchmarks.

Specifically, starting July 1, 2019, the specifications for Platts FOB Singapore 92 RON gasoline grade, FOB Singapore 95 RON and FOB Singapore 97 RON would see a reduction in the sulfur level from current 350 ppm to 50 ppm, Reid Vapor Pressure from 9.5 PSI to 9 PSI, and final boiling point from 225 degrees to 215 degrees. Platts will also include new limits on aromatics at 40% and olefins at 25%. The changes reflect evolving gasoline quality standards in Asia, where gasoline trading reflects supply and demand across the Asia Pacific and the Middle East. NYMEX lists eleven (11) Singapore gasoline futures and options contracts in the table below (the “Contracts”) for trading the CME Globex electronic trading platform and for clearing via CME ClearPort. Currently there is no open interest in the July 2019 contact month and beyond of the Contracts.
