SUBJECT: Platts Announcement to Amend Singapore 92 RON, 95 RON, 97 RON Gasoline Specifications Effective July 2019

New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") has been advised that S&P Global Platts ("Platts") will amend its methodology for assessing its FOB Singapore Gasoline 92 RON unleaded, 95 RON unleaded and 97 RON unleaded benchmarks.

Specifically, starting July 1, 2019, the specifications for Platts FOB Singapore 92 RON gasoline grade, FOB Singapore 95 RON and FOB Singapore 97 RON would see a reduction in the sulfur level from current 350 ppm to 50 ppm, Reid Vapor Pressure from 9.5 PSI to 9 PSI, and final boiling point from 225 degrees to 215 degrees. Platts will also include new limits on aromatics at 40% and olefins at 25%. The changes reflect evolving gasoline quality standards in Asia, where gasoline trading reflects supply and demand across the Asia Pacific and the Middle East.
