Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of June 20, 2016.

On Thursday, June 23, 2016, the Exchange was notified that Scale Distribution, Inc., a warehouse regular for storage of aluminum and zinc, has changed its name to Metal Ox Warehousing, Inc. This name change is due to an ownership change. The marketplace was notified of this approval via MKR# 06-23-16, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

On Thursday, June 23, 2016, The Commodity Exchange, Inc. approved the application of Metal Ox Warehousing, Inc. for a decrease in regularity of aluminum and zinc at their location in Ypsilanti, MI. The new approved cumulative capacity of this facility is 15,000 metric tons.
