New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") that it is self-certifying amendments to NYMEX Rule 589. ("Special Price Fluctuation Limits and Daily Price Limits") table (the "Table") for the Brent Last Day Financial Futures contract (the "Contract") listed in Table 1. below (the "Rule Amendments") effective Sunday, July 15, 2018 for trade date Monday, July 16, 2018.

The Global Command Center ("GCC") of CME Group implemented a procedure to monitor circuit breaker levels to maintain a consistent level of circuit breakers as a percentage of the product's value. The target was set at approximately 10% for energy products.

Recent price movements in the Contract has indicated that modifying the current circuit breaker levels is appropriate in order to facilitate an orderly market.

 effectively protect the market from large price fluctuations of the Contracts. The Exchange believes
 that the amendments are consistent with this Core Principle requiring the Exchange to maintain
 and promote an orderly market.
- Availability of General Information: The Exchange will amend the NYMEX rulebook accordingly
 on the effective date which is publicly available on the CME Group website. In addition, the
 Exchange will publish industry notifications to advise the marketplace of these amendments. The
 industry notifications will also be posted on the CME Group website.

• <u>Execution of Transactions</u>: The Rule Amendments will further enable the Exchange to continue its current practice of providing a competitive, open, and efficient market mechanism for executing transactions.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Act and CFTC Regulation 40.6(a), the Exchange hereby certifies that the Rule Amendments comply with the Act, including all regulations under the Act. There were no substantive opposing views to this proposal.
