Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of July 1, 2019.

Effective Sunday, June 30, 2019 for trade date Monday, July 1, 2019, the Exchange implemented administrative amendments to the contract titles of fourteen (14) refined petroleum futures contracts. The marketplace was alerted of these changes via Special Executive Report ("SER") #8398, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Effective July 1, 2019, the Exchange approved all applications for the declaration of regulatory for the delivery of NYMEX Platinum and NYMEX Palladium. The marketplace was alerted of the approvals via MKR #07-01-19C, which is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

In accordance with the changes above, the Exchange updated the NYMEX Rulebook Chapter 7 "Service Providers" Chart ("Chart") for "Precious Depository Weighmaster." The Chart is attached under separate cover, in blackline format, as Exhibit C.
