Dear Mr. Kirkpatrick:

Pursuant to Section 5c(c)(1) of the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended, and Commission Regulation 40.6(d), ICE Futures U.S., Inc. ("Exchange") submits notification to the Commission that, effective September 1, 2020, the third-party index provider amended the computation of indices which underly the Crude Diff - ICE SYN 1A Index Future ("TMS"), Crude Diff - ICE SYN 1B Index Future ("SYN") futures, and Crude Diff - ICE SYN 1a Index Average Price Option ("TMS") contracts. Specifically, ICE-NGX will include all trades executed in the Crude Firm Phys CNS, ID, WTI, EDM-Horizon Pipeline products in the SYN 1a and SYN 1b indices. The futures and options products do not currently have any open interest. The notice by ICE-NGX is provided as Exhibit A.
