New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or the "Exchange") is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or the "Commission") that it is self-certifying amendments to the NYMEX Rulebook Chapter 5 Position Limit, Position Accountability, and Reportable Level Table (the "Table") in connection with the Australian Coking Coal (Platts) Low Vol Futures contract (the "Contract") (Rule Chapter: 1111, Commodity Code: ALW) effective on trade date October 2, 2017 and commencing with the October 2017 contract month and beyond.

Specifically, the Exchange will add diminishing balances to the Contract because the floating price for the Contract is calculated as the average price of all daily price assessments for a given calendar month. The addition of diminishing balances will not have an impact on the value of the Contract. Diminishing balance contracts are those whose front month open positions, as counted for position limit purposes, diminish as the contract month progresses toward expiration.

Amendments to the Table are provided under separate cover as Exhibit A with additions underscored.

The Exchange reviewed the designated contract market core principles ("Core Principles") as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and identified that the amendments to the Table may have some bearing on the following Core Principle:

• Availability of General Information: In order to ensure that market participants are apprised of the revisions and the administrative amendments to the Table, the Exchange will issue a CME Group Market Surveillance Notice (the "Notice") to the marketplace notifying them of the amendment in advance of the amendment becoming effective. The Notice will also be posted on the CME Group website.

The Exchange certifies that the amendments to the Table comply with the Act and regulations thereunder. There were no opposing views to the aforementioned amendments.
