New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) that it is self-certifying the expansion of the contract month listing of the U.S. Midwest Domestic Hot-Rolled Coil Steel (CRU) Index futures contract (“Contract”) for trading on CME Globex and for submission for clearing through CME ClearPort, effective on Sunday, October 19, 2014 for trade date Monday, October 20, 2014.

Contract Size	20 Short Tons
Current Listing Schedule	Trading is conducted in the nearest 24 consecutive months
Amended Listing Schedule	Trading is conducted in the current calendar year and the next two calendar years. Following the expiry of the December contract, a new calendar year will be listed.

Exchange business staff responsible for the amendment and the Exchange Legal Department collectively reviewed the designated contract market core principles (“Core Principles”) as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act (“CEA” or “Act”). During the review, Exchange staff identified that the amendment may have some bearing on the following Core Principles:

- **Availability of General Information:** The Exchange will publish information on the Contract’s specification on its website, together with daily trading volume, open interest and price information. The Exchange will notify the marketplace of the expanded listing schedule via a Special Executive Report (“SER”). The SER will also be posted on CME Group website.
- **Daily Publication of Trading Information:** Trading volume, open interest and price information will be published daily on the Exchange’s website and via quote vendors.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Act and CFTC Regulation 40.6(a), the Exchange hereby certifies that the amendment complies with the Act, including regulations under the Act. There were no substantive opposing views to the amendment.
