Amendments to the Spot Call Butter Contract

Effective Sunday, October 14, 2018 for trade date Monday, October 15, 2018, Chicago Mercantile Exchange Inc. ("CME" or "Exchange") will amend Rule 1205.A. ("Contract Specifications") of the Spot Call Butter contract (Rulebook Chapter: 12; CME Direct Auction Code: AAX) (the "Contract") to add the requirement that all butter sold pursuant to the auction shall be certified Kosher. 1205. SPOT CALL BUTTER

1205.A. Commodity Specifications

Definitions

- 1. The "spot call" is the procedure for trading and delivering cash butter as more fully set forth in this chapter.
- 2. "Butter means salted butter that conforms to the definition of butter contained in 21 U.S.C. ∫ 321a, is made entirely from sweet cream, and, if graded by USDA, would be certified Grade AA Butter. All butter shall be certified Kosher by a Rabbinical Service that provides Kosher classification.
