New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or the "Exchange") is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or the "Commission") that it is self-certifying amendments to the NYMEX Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table (the "Table") located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 of the NYMEX Rulebook effective on November 14, 2016. A summary of the amendments is provided below.

- Platinum and Palladium Options: The Exchange is amending the single month and all month accountability levels to render them consistent with those of the respective underlying parent futures contracts.
- U.S. Midwest Domestic Hot-Rolled Coil Steel (CRU) Index Futures and Average Price Option: The Exchange is reducing the position reportable levels into the Large Trader Reporting System from 250 to 25 lots to bring the contracts in line with the reportable levels of the Exchange's other financially settled metals contracts.
- Options on Quarterly and Calendar Futures Strip for certain coal and crude oil contracts: The Exchange is amending the "All Month Aggregate into Ratio" to correct a typographical error and reflect the correct size of the strip (i.e., 3 months (quarterly) or 12 months (calendar)).

The amended Table is set forth in Appendix A (under separate cover), with additions underscored and deletions overstruck.

The Exchange reviewed the designated contract market core principles ("Core Principles") as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and identified that the amendments to the Table may have some bearing on the following Core Principle:

Availability of General Information:

In order to ensure that market participants are apprised of the aforementioned amendments, the Exchange will issue a CME Group Market Surveillance Notice to the marketplace notifying them of the implementation of these amendments in advance of the amendments becoming effective. The issuance of the Market Surveillance Notice constitutes compliance with this Core Principle.

The Exchange certifies that the amendments to the Table comply with the Act and regulations thereunder. There were no opposing views to the amendments to the Table.
