New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX") and Commodity Exchange, Inc. ("COMEX") (collectively, the "Exchanges") are notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or the "Commission") that they are self-certifying amendments to NYMEX/COMEX Rulebook Chapter 7 ("Delivery Facilities and Procedures"). In anticipation of approving Asian-based warehouses, the Exchanges are amending Rule 703. ("Designation and Obligations of Metal Service Providers") in order to expand the location for the storage and delivery of lead delivered against the COMEX Lead Futures contract to Asia effective on Thursday, December 14, 2016 and commencing with the January 2017 delivery contract month and beyond. Currently, lead delivered against the Lead Futures contract is deliverable in the Continental United States and the European Union.

NYMEX/COMEX Chapter 7, Rule 703. is set forth in Appendix A, with additions underscored and deletions overstruck.

The Exchanges reviewed the designated contract market core principles ("Core Principles") as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and identified that the amendments to NYMEX/COMEX Rulebook Chapter 7 may have some bearing on the following Core Principle:

<u>Availability of General Information</u>: In order to ensure that market participants are apprised of the amendment to NYMEX/COMEX Chapter 7, the Exchanges will issue a CME Group Market Surveillance Notice and a Registrar's Office Notice to the marketplace notifying them of the implementation of this amendment in advance of the amendment becoming effective. The Market Surveillance Notice and the Registrar's Office Notice will also be posted on the CME Group website.

The Exchanges certify that the amendments to NYMEX/COMEX Chapter 7 comply with the Act and regulations thereunder. There were no opposing views to the amendments.
