Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") Regulation 40.4(b)(5), The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc. ("CBOT" or "Exchange") is notifying the CFTC that it is self-certifying the following non-material agricultural rule amendments to CBOT Chapter 7 ("Delivery Facilities and Procedures") in connection with minimum financial requirements for agricultural regularity effective on December 26, 2018.

- (1) Chapter 7, Rule 708 "Minimum Financial Requirements for Agricultural Regularity". Incorporate into Rule 708.2 ("Net Worth") an amendment to restrict rough rice facilities from issuing new shipping certificates if, at the time of issuance, the total value of all registered shipping certificates and the new shipping certificates exceeds 100% of the facility's net worth. Rough Rice facilities wishing to issue shipping certificates greater than net worth must deposit U.S. Treasury securities or other collateral deemed acceptable to the Exchange. Net worth requirements for all other CBOT agriculture and ethanol products will remain unchanged. This amendment is intended to minimize the financial risk associated with Exchange approved rough rice facilities. The Exchange considers this change non-material as there is no material impact to the terms or conditions as defined under CFTC Regulation 40.1(j).
- (2) Administrative amendments to CBOT Rulebook Chapter 7 to delete obsolete references to the delisted EU Wheat futures contract.

The amendments to Chapter 7, provided under separate cover in Appendix A, contains Chapter 7 in its entirety with additions underlined and deletions struck through.

The Exchange reviewed the designated contract market core principles ("Core Principles") as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act ("CEA" or "Act") and identified that the following Core Principle may be impacted by this initiative as follows:

<u>Availability of General Information:</u> The Exchange will make publicly available the details of the
amendments herein by publishing a Registrar's Office Notice ("MKR") to the market. The MKR will
be available on CME Group's website.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Act and CFTC Regulations 40.4(b)(5a), the Exchange hereby certifies that the amendments comply with the Act, including regulations under the Act. There were no substantive opposing views to the proposal by market participants.
