Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of December 14, 2020.

Effective December 17, 2020, the Exchange amended CBOT Rule 13109.B.(e) ("Loading and Shipment of Meal Against Meal Shipping Certificates") of the Soybean Meal Futures contract (the "Contract") to correct a typographical error in the Rule. Specifically, effective December 24, 2018, CBOT implemented amendments to the Contract to increase the storage charge (see CBOT Submission No. 18-444 dated November 9, 2018). At that time, the Exchange neglected to implement corresponding amendments to Rule 13109.B.(e) to reflect that change. Amendments to Rule 13109.B.(e) are provided in Exhibit A below with additions underscored and deletions struck through.

Chapter 13 Soybean Meal Futures

(additions underscored; deletions struck through)

13109. REGULARITY OF WAREHOUSES AND ISSUERS OF SHIPPING CERTIFICATES

13109.B. Loading and Shipment of Meal Against Meal Shipping Certificates

(e) The shipper shall assess a premium charge of 7 12 cents per ton per calendar day for each day a Soybean Meal Shipping Certificate is outstanding starting the day after the date of registration by the Registrar. When rail loading orders specify shipment within four business days the premium charge shall continue through the business day following the receipt of loading orders. Otherwise, the premium charge shall continue through the day of rail loading. "Business days" are those on which the Exchange is open for trading Soybean Meal. In the case of shipment by truck, the premium charge shall continue through the day of loading.
