The identified vendor is the sole provider of this product and there is no known alternative source to the Know-How E-Learning Library. Therefore, this vendor is the only responsible source identified as reasonably available that will satisfy the agency requirements.

However, the Government will consider written responses from all responsible sources received by 5:00pm local (Washington, DC) on July 16, 2024. Written responses must include sufficient information to establish capability to fulfill the requirement. Any responses received will only be considered for the purpose of determining whether to conduct a competitive procurement in lieu of the sole source contract described in this notice, and such determination shall be made at the sole discretion of CFTC.
