**ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

On January 28, 2008, we issued an order directing Mohinder Paul and Mukesh Paul Sodhi to show cause why their complaint should not be dismissed on grounds that they (1) are not residents of United States and (2) have not complied with 17 C.F.R. §12.13(b)(4)(i) by either posting a bond or demonstrating an adequate basis for waiving the bond requirement.<sup>1</sup> They have not filed a response to the order nor have they otherwise demonstrated compliance with Rule 12.13(b)(4)(i). Accordingly, we **DISMISS** the complaint **without prejudice**.
