Chicago Mercantile Exchange Inc. ("CME" or "Exchange") hereby notifies the Commodity Futures Trading Commission per the exchange certification procedure that the Exchange will delist S&P 500/ Technology SPCTR Futures (Chapter 365) and S&P 500/ Financial SPCTR Futures (Chapter 366) contracts effective Monday, March 21, 2011, following the expiration of the March 2011 expiry contracts.

The S&P 500/ Technology SPCTR Futures and the S&P 500/ Financial SPCTR Futures contracts began trading on September 23, 2002. The S&P 500/ Technology SPCTR Futures contract has not traded since November 25, 2009. Open Interest in S&P 500/ Technology SPCTR Futures is currently zero contracts while open interest in the S&P 500/ Financial SPCTR Futures is currently sixty-three (63) contracts. The S&P 500/ Technology SPCTR Futures and S&P 500/ Financial SPCTR Futures contracts will be replaced by S&P Technology Select Sector Index Futures and S&P Financial Select Sector Futures (See CME Submission No. 11-073).

The Exchange certifies that this action neither violates nor is inconsistent with any provision of the Commodity Exchange Act or regulations thereunder.
