Dear Mr. Stawick:

The New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") that it is self-certifying amendments to NYMEX Rules 9A.26, All Month/Any One Month Accountability Levels, 9A.27, Expiration Month Limits, and 9A.34 Reporting Levels, in relation to the listing of thirteen (13) new petroleum swap futures contracts.

These amendments establish the accountability levels, position limits, and reportable levels for the new contracts. In addition, an administrative amendment was made to the aggregation allocation for the EIA On-Highway Retail Diesel Swap Contract that was affected with the launch of the aforementioned 13 new petroleum swap futures contracts.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and CFTC Rule 40.6, the Exchange hereby certifies that the attached rule amendments comply with the Act, including regulations under the Act. These changes will be made effective on trade date March 9, 2009.
