Notification. New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. Submission #09.57. Notification Regarding the Renumbering of NYMEX Chapter 90 (Platinum Futures Contract) and NYMEX Chapter 100A (Palladium Futures Contract) and Revisions to Rule 7A.01 (Definitions), Rule 7A.04 (Warrants) and Appendix A, Chapter 9A (Position Limits, Accountability Levels and Reportable Levels) to Reflect the Renumbering

Dear Mr. Stawick:

The New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") that it is renumbering current Chapters 90 (Platinum Futures Contract) and 100A (Palladium Futures Contract) of the NYMEX Rulebook. Chapter 90 is being renumbered Chapter 105 and Chapter 100A is being renumbered Chapter 106. Based on the renumbering, other references to Chapters 90 and 100 in Rules 7A.01 (Definitions) and 7A.04 (Warrants) and in Appendix A to Chapter 9A are being revised to refer correctly to Chapters 105 and 106. The renumbering results from upcoming improvements being planned for the online Rulebook in order to ensure that all non-product chapters precede the product chapters. The revision will facilitate the display of the titles of the non-product chapters upon implementation of the improvements.

The Exchange is notifying the CFTC of this rule change pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and CFTC Rule 40.6(c). These changes become effective immediately.

- (aa) "Platinum" shall mean platinum that meets the specifications for delivery in fulfillment of a Platinum Futures Contract, as stated in the Platinum Futures Contract contained in Chapter 10599 of the Exchange Rule Book.
