Re: Delayed Listing of Certain New Energy Futures Contracts -Submission Pursuant to Section 5c(c)(1) of the Act and Regulations 40.2

Dear Ms. Jurgens:

In Submission No. 13-37, filed on April 10, 2013, ICE Futures U.S., Inc. ("Exchange") self certified the terms and conditions of fourteen (14) new Energy futures contracts for listing on April 29, 2013. The Exchange is hereby amending Submission No. 13-37 pursuant to Commission Regulation 40.2, to delay the listing date for five (5) of the fourteen (14) new futures contracts.

The listing of the four (4) new physical environmental futures contracts identified below has been postponed. These contracts will now be listed for trading on Monday, May 20, 2013.

Contract Name
CAIR Annual NOx Futures
CAIR Ozone Season Futures
New Jersey Solar Renewable Energy Certificate Futures
Texas Compliance Renewable Energy Certificate Futures

In addition, listing of the natural gas liquid futures contract, the Condensate, Diff – TMX C5 IB futures, has also been postponed. The Exchange has not set a new listing date for this contract at this time. The other nine (9) new Energy futures contracts will be listed for trading on April 29, 2013 as originally filed.

The Exchange certifies that the delayed listing of the contracts comply with the requirements of the CEA and the rules and regulations promulgated by the Commission thereunder. The Exchange is not aware of any substantive opposing views expressed with respect to the rules and the amendments. The Exchange further certifies that concurrent with this filing, a copy of this submission was posted on the Exchange's website.
