The New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") that it is self-certifying a change in the listing date for the following eight (8) electricity swap futures contracts listed for trading and for submission for clearing on CME ClearPort.

According to submission #09-101, filed with the Commission on June 9, 2009, the first listed contract day for the above-referenced, peak and off-peak, calendar-day, electricity swap futures contracts was scheduled to be July 1, 2009. Due to customer demand, the Exchange seeks to list the ERCOT calendar-day swap futures contracts beginning with the June 18, 2009 contract day. The daily ERCOT contracts will continue to list current month plus the next month.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and CFTC Rule 40.6, the Exchange hereby certifies that the amendment to listing date complies with the Act, including regulations under the Act. The new listing date for these contracts will become effective on trade date June 18, 2009.
