Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 5c(c)(1) of the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended ("Act"), and Section 40.6 of the regulations promulgated by the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC") under the Act, the NASDAQ OMX Futures Exchange ("NFX" or "Exchange") hereby submits new Rule 213, *Information Sharing Agreements*.

Section 735 of the Dodd Frank Act amended Section 5 of the Act concerning designation and operation of contract markets. In part, it amended Core Principle 2 to provide in part that "[t]he rules of the contract market shall provide the board of trade with the ability and authority to obtain any necessary information to perform any function described in this section, including the capacity to carry out such international information-sharing agreements, as the Commission may require." In order to comply with Core Principle 2, as amended, the Exchange is adopting new Rule 213 as set forth below.

NASDAQ OMX FUTURES EXCHANGE RULEBOOK

New language is underlined; deletions are struck through

Rule 213. Information Sharing Agreements. The Exchange shall have the ability and authority to obtain any necessary information to perform any function described in Section 5 of the Commodity Exchange Act, including the capacity to carry out such international information-sharing agreements as the Commission may require.

Rule 213 will become effective July 16, 2011.
