Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or the "Commission") Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchanges submit this Weekly Notification of the following rule amendments:

Effective Monday, May 21, 2012

 NYMEX reduced the minimum price fluctuation limit for 12 petroleum swap futures contracts listed for trading on the NYMEX trading floor and clearing through CME ClearPort. The notification of this reduction was inadvertently omitted from the May 28, 2012 weekly notification filing and should have been included in that filing. Rule amendments relating to this reduction are provided under Special Executive Report ("SER") 6215 which has been attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Effective Wednesday, June 20, 2012

Los Angeles Jet Fuel (Platts) vs. Heating Oil Spread Swap futures contract (commodity code MQ, chapter 609) contract month July 2012 through contract month March 2013 were made available for trading on the NYMEX trading floor and clearing through CME ClearPort. The announcement regarding the listing of additional contract months is provided under SER-6291 which has been attached hereto as Exhibit B.

Effective Friday, June 22, 2012
