Rule Certification. New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. Submission #09.132R: Notification of Revision to Submission #09.132 Relating to Amendments to NYMEX Rules 9A.26 and 9A.27 in Connection with the SO<sub>2</sub> Emission 25-Allowance Futures Contracts

Dear Mr. Stawick:

Previously, by letter dated July 9, 2009 (submission #09.132), the New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") notified the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") that it was self-certifying amendments to Chapter 9A, Appendix A, in connection with the launch of new SO<sub>2</sub> Emission 25-Allowance Futures contracts. This letter is intended to revise submission #09.132 in order to correct inadvertent clerical errors to the all month/any one month accountability levels (NYMEX Rule 9A.26), the expiration month position limits (NYMEX Rule 9A.27) and aggregation allocations for the six contracts. These revisions are included herewith in Appendix A. All other contents of the submission #09.132 remain unchanged.

Please note that the amendments to Appendix A attached herewith reflect expiration month position limits expressed in the futures equivalent of the contract into which the  $SO_2$  Emission 25-Allowance Futures contracts aggregate. Therefore, the expiration month position limits of the  $SO_2$  Emission 25-Allowance Futures contracts continue to be 10,000 contracts or 2,500 RS-equivalent contracts, as reflected in the attached amendment to Appendix A.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and CFTC Rule 40.6, the Exchange hereby certifies that the attached rule amendments comply with the Act, including regulations under the Act. These changes will be made effective on trade date July 21, 2009.
