Submission #10-254: Notification of Amendments to Chapter 5, Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table of the NYMEX Rulebook Relating to the Launch of Ten (10) New Euro Mini and Daily Petroleum Contracts, and an Administrative Amendment to the Aggregation Allocation for an Existing Related Contract

Dear Mr. Stawick:

The New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") that it is self-certifying amendments to the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 of the NYMEX Rulebook in relation to the listing of ten (10) new Euro Mini and Daily petroleum contracts. These amendments establish the all month/any one month accountability levels, expiration month position limits, reportable levels, and aggregation allocations for the new contracts.

In addition, the aggregation allocation was amended for the Premium Unleaded 10 ppm (Platts) Cargoes CIF NEW BALMO Swap Futures contract that is affected by the launch of the new contracts.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and CFTC Rule 40.6, the Exchange hereby certifies that the attached rule amendments comply with the Act, including regulations under the Act. These changes will be made effective on trade date September 13, 2010.
