The current listing cycle for US Weekly weather contracts are for two weeks and the expansion will increase the listing cycle to four weeks. The increase in the listing cycle is to better to match the needs of the energy market with the weekly demand driven by temperature.

The expanded listing range will go into effect on October 19, 2009.
