**RE: Revision to CME Rule 501 (“Employees of Members”)

Dear Mr. Stawick:

Chicago Mercantile Exchange Inc. (“CME”) hereby notifies the Commodity Futures Trading Commission that it is eliminating outdated language from Rule 501 (“Employees of Members”) concerning former Rule 140 (“Agricultural Business Solicitation Permit Program”) which was previously deleted by CME.

The revision appears below with deletions overstruck and is effective immediately.

Rule 501. EMPLOYEES OF MEMBERS

Members shall register with the Exchange all persons whom they wish to employ on the trading floor. Such employees may act as runners, communicators, clerks and broker assistants. Such employees shall not be permitted to solicit customers or benefit from the production of orders, ~~except as provided in Rule 140.~~

[The remainder of the rule is unchanged.]

CME certifies that the revision complies with the Commodity Exchange Act and regulations thereunder.
